I have witnessed firsthand both the challenges and the profound impact that a stable, supportive environment can have on children in state custody. This bill is a vital step toward strengthening the rights of foster youth and ensuring that caregivers, including foster and kinship parents, receive the respect and support they need to provide the best possible care.HB 945 reinforces the Foster Youth Bill of Rights, ensuring that children in state custody have essential protections, including: The right to live in a safe, stable, and nurturing environment. The right to maintain family connections, including visits with siblings and relatives. The right to educational continuity, reducing unnecessary school disruptions. The right to be informed of and participate in court proceedings affecting their future. The right to privately communicate with cases managers, attorneys, and advocates. Additionally, the bill strengthens the Foster Parents' Bill of Rights by recognizing kinship foster parents—grandparents, relatives, or close family friends who step in to provide a safe and loving home. As a former foster parent, I know how critical it is that caregivers are treated fairly and not subjected to discrimination when working with the Children's Division and its contractors. This legislation ensures that kinship foster parents are afforded the same rights and considerations as traditional foster parents.HB 945 also mandates timely and individualized permanency and case plans, ensuring that foster children are not left in limbo without a clear path forward. These measures will help reduce placement instability and provide foster youth with the security and guidance they need to transition successfully into adulthood.Missouri's foster children deserve to be protected, heard, and supported.
