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Since 2020, 100% of the population loss in the Saint Louis MSA has come from one sobering reality: more people are dying than being born. For over a decade, more domestic residents have moved out of the region than have moved in. Saint Louis City and County continue to shrink, as our population ages and birth rates fall sharply. In the last year alone, births dropped by 1,752—from 28,149 to 26,397. Over the past two years, the total decline is 3,645 births. If this trend continues, annual births could fall below 20,000 by 2029, leaving us with fewer than 100,000 children in the region by 2035—a dramatic drop from 216,000 in 1980. This isn't just a local concern. A shrinking, aging region weakens the future of the entire state. Despite these statistics. I've seen signs of deep hope. Since COVID, I've had the opportunity to meet hundreds of residents across every part of this region. In neighborhood meetings, roundtables, and conversations over coffee, a message has come through loud and clear: the people of Saint Louis are ready for something better. They want more than maintenance. They're hungry for a Saint Louis that isn't stuck in its past but is radically committed to its future. They want a place that welcomes young families, supports new life, retains and attracts talent, and makes the common good not just a value but a lived reality. This is the heart of One Saint Louis. A Saint Louis rooted not in fragmentation, but in solidarity. One Saint Louis that dares to reform itself-urgently, courageously-for the sake of those who live here now and those who have yet to be born. It is a moral call, not just an economic one. If we truly care about our children, our neighborhoods, our schools, and our shared future, then we cannot wait. The time for action is now. Let's shape a Saint Louis where the common good is not just spoken but lived—a region ready to welcome a new generation of Americans who will plant roots here, raise families, and build businesses that strengthen us all.

April 27, 2025Testimony in Support of HJR 27I write to express my support for HJR 27 calling for a merger btwn St. Louis City & County. The need to do so has always struck me as self-evident, especially after returning home to St. Louis after sixteen years in New York. When I returned home in 2010, I was shocked to find downtown St. Louis resembled a ghost town compared to the thriving region I remembered as a child. Meeting my father for lunch downtown c. 1982 was akin to walking thru Chicago, albeit on a considerably smaller scale. Yet, the density of foot traffic then is hard to square with the utter absence of people today. All cities experience suburban flight, poverty, deindustrialization, crime, et al. Yet, no other city I can think of features a municipal bifurcation that inhibits the dynamism of the entire region. Downtown St. Louis isn't languishing because of crime. It languishes because it competes with St. Louis County for economic resources - a conflict no other City I can think of contends with. The fight to lure businesses from the City to the County is a zero-sum game: a law firm either occupies office space in one district or the other. Each time a business relocates to St. Louis County, it depletes the City's tax base. In turn, that creates a destabilizing cycle that leads to greater City depopulation and a corresponding decrease in social stability, amplifying those issues in a self-perpetuating cycle. Depopulation, crime, the loss of tax revenue, business relocation, and every other issue that impacts the City of St. Louis is not organic - it has a cause: the bifurcation of City and County Every skyscraper that emerges from the ground in St. Louis County, luring law firms, corporations, et al from the City, represents a corresponding vacancy in a City building that each relocated County business once occupied. The battle for relocation is a source of economic and demographic conflict that other cities, with far more dynamism, like Chicago, Nashville, Denver, et al don't face.Rex Sinquefield's Better Together project had the right idea, even if his efforts to impel a merger failed because of his organization's top-down approach disguised as a grass-roots effort.Our municipal barrier burdens the region. Removing it would unleash a demographic dynamism that is the lifeblood of every thriving city. I think most people recognize this fact - yet, actualizing a marriage btwn City and County is akin to dragging a steamship up the side of a mountain, a la the film "Fitzcarraldo."For these reasons, I offer my unalloyed support to Rep. I write today in strong support of HJR 27, which proposes a badly needed merger of St. Louis City and St. Louis County into a single, accountable regional government. As an employee of the St. Louis City Sheriff's Office, I've had a front row seat to the inner workings of city government and what I've seen is shocking. The City of St. Louis is like a bank for corrupt politics, a place where personal agendas. insider deals, and political favoritism take priority over public service. Far too many in leadership treat city government as a source of power and profit, not a duty to the people. Dysfunction is normal and reform is nearly impossible from within. It is becoming clear that the city can no longer govern itself in its current form. It needs a reset and HJR 27 is that opportunity. What our region desperately needs is a comprehensive strategy to make the St. Louis competitive again. In my 28 years on earth, I've watched as other metropolitan areas have flourished while we've gone in the wrong direction under fragmented governance. A unified government structure would finally enable us to develop and execute a cohesive plan for regional growth. I understand many county residents have legitimate concerns about being forced to subsidize the city's aging water infrastructure and other legacy costs. These concerns are valid. Currently, the city lacks sufficient resources to modernize its deteriorating water system without imposing substantial rate hikes on its shrinking population which creates an unsustainable financial burden. Neither continued deterioration nor are massive rate increases viable solutions. This merger would position us to attract major investments and opportunities that have passed us by, including the return of an NBA franchise that could boost our economy and national profile. It would allow us to modernize and fully utilize our underperforming port facilities along the Mississippi River to capitalize on our strategic location at the heart of America's waterway system. Consolidating our government could address our crumbling infrastructure with a coordinated approach rather than the piecemeal efforts that leave residents frustrated, facing a patchwork of road conditions and utility services as they cross invisible municipal lines. Perhaps most critically, this merger would create the framework needed to transform our broken public school system, eliminating the stark disparities between districts and ensuring quality education for all children regardless of zip code. The merger would eliminate costly redundancies, streamline public services, and give our region a chance to operate with the professionalism and integrity our citizens deserve. It would also bring oversight and accountability to a structure that has, for decades, operated with little of either, A unified government could finally begin addressing the serious issues we face from violent crime to failing infrastructure without being paralyzed by soft-witted leadership and senseless political fights. This is about the future of our region. The people of St. Louis City and County deserve a government that works for them, not just for the connected few. I urge you to support HJR 27 and give the voters a voice in reshaping the government they fund and creating a St. Louis region that can truly compete on the national and global stage.

Mr. Chairman, Members of the Emerging Issues Committee, Thank you for the opportunity to discuss Representative Mackey's bill, HJR 27, which revives the Better Together proposal to consolidate the governments of St. Louis County and the City of St. Louis. I oppose this bill. Given the resounding defeat of Better Together in the court of public opinion several years ago, I will keep my remarks brief. The bill undermines local control of government and services. For more than 125 years, our residents have built a highly desirable, economically diverse community. The residents of Webster Groves have a real fear that we will lose control of our identity and community character if forced to give up our ability to enact policies relating to zoning, sustainability, historic preservation, taxation and public safety. The bill also seeks to dissolve the most effective governmental organizations in the St. Louis area. While no municipality is perfect, the municipal governments of St. Louis County provide some of the most efficient and cost-effective services in the state. Our legislative bodies, City Councils and Boards of Aldermen, work hard to ensure that tax payer funds are spent in ways that reflect the needs and priorities of our communities. Recent history suggests that the larger governments in our area struggle to meet that same standard. While one of the central themes of regional consolidation is the belief that there will be specific cost savings, there is no evidence to back up this claim of direct financial benefits to taxpayers. In addition, enactment of the governmental structure outlined in this bill rests on a statewide vote. That means any adoption of the structure will not necessarily reflect the will of the communities involved. That robs St. Louis City and County residents of their right to determine how to govern themselves. I do recognize that fragmentation sometimes gets in our way as local leaders and as a region. We should continue to consider ways to achieve better service provision, greater efficiency, improvements in our national reputation and economic development. That means thinking beyond this outdated proposal and to new ideas that our residents can and will support. Thank you for your time.Laura ArnoldMayor of Webster Groves

Good afternoon, Chair and Members of the Committee, Although I am unable to be present in person for today's hearing. I appreciate the opportunity to submit this written testimony for the official record. My name is Colonel Tameika Sanders, and I serve as the municipal Chief of Police for the Normandy Police Department, Normandy, MO. I am also a homeowner and resident of unincorporated St. Louis County.I speak today from both a professional and personal perspective; as a law enforcement leader who serves a community daily, and as a resident who experiences firsthand the gaps and inefficiencies of larger government structures.Let me be clear: I am not speaking to protect a title or a municipality. I am here to advocate for governance that is accountable, effective, and truly centered on the people it claims to serve. I support regional cooperation, I support innovation, and I believe in efficient, inclusive public service. And if there were a well-defined, evidence-based proposal that clearly improved public safety, fiscal responsibility, and equity, I would support it. This is not about power. This is about people.But what is being proposed lacks the structure, detail, and data that any sound public reform requires. It's not enough to point to regional problems and promise a fix, we need to know how. This merger proposal contains no tested model, no verifiable benefit, and no clear safeguards for community voice or local representation. It risks widening the gap between government and the people it exists to serve. It identifies real concerns: fragmentation, financial strain, and crime; but offers no substantiated plan for how consolidating jurisdictions will solve them. It relies on generalities and aspirational language, not measurable outcomes or grounded strategy. Critically, the financial risks of this proposal cannot be overlooked. The City of St. Louis is carrying nearly \$1 billion in debt, while St. Louis County faces a multi-billion-dollar infrastructure deficit and ongoing budgetary pressures. This merger would not eliminate those obligations. On the contrary, it would redistribute them across a broader population, including communities that have worked hard to remain financially stable. Without a transparent, long-term fiscal strategy, we risk compounding, not correcting, regional strain. I would stand behind any plan that makes us safer, more united, and more accountable, even if it meant giving up my role. But I cannot support an undefined promise over proven proximity, especially in communities already struggling to be heard. And that is the heart of the issue: this merger would move decisions further away from the people. It risks weakening local representation, diluting public safety efforts, and redistributing debt without a clear plan for stability or success. Local governments, particularly those built through grassroots incorporation, exist because residents sought something better. That should not be erased, it should be respected. As a resident, I live the experience of unincorporated governance daily. My neighbors and I have watched nearby communities incorporate, and we hope to follow their lead. Not for prestige, but because we want to protect our most significant investments: our families, our homes, and our futures. The level of service provided by the County has too often lacked urgency, consistency, or meaningful engagement. For us, incorporation isn't about

control, it's about hope. A hope that services will be delivered with intention. Hope that someone will answer when we call. Hope that our voices will matter when decisions are made. And let us not overlook the issue of representation. Local government has long served as a vital pathway for civic participation, particularly in African American communities. If we restructure without deliberate safeguards for inclusion and access, we risk undoing decades of progress. That is not reform—it is regression. We don't need to be rescued; we need to be respected. In closing, I urge this committee to weigh this proposal not by its intentions, but by its merits. Not by what it promises, but by what it lacks. Good governance doesn't just diagnose problems, it delivers solutions, grounded in planning, backed by data, and built alongside the people it is meant to serve. Thank you for your time, your commitment, and for considering the full impact this proposal could have on the people who live, serve, and hope in this region.
