The Missouri Catholic Conference supports SB 10, as it would ensure that several valuable provisions would remain in place by repealing their respective expiration dates. Specifically, we support the removal of the expiration date for sections 135.621, 163.048, and 191.1720 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri. The first one would keep the diaper bank tax credit, allowing these organizations to continue helping families who lack access to items that are essential to the health and well-being of children, in accordance with their inherent God-given dignity. This is part of the efforts from both the Catholic Church and society at large to create a culture of life and compassion. The second provision would guarantee that fundamental fairness and safety for female athletes seeking to participate in interscholastic sports remains the norm in Missouri. Preventing biological males from competing against biological females protects the dignity of female athletes, respects justice and the common good, and ensures that our laws comport with a proper understanding of human nature. Finally, the third would ensure that minors continue to be protected from surgical procedures, life-altering crosssex hormones, and puberty blocking drugs that, based on a false understanding of human nature, attempt to change their sex. Furthermore, we are concerned that minors are not capable of giving truly informed consent to dangerous treatment that could lead to irreversible consequences, such as infertility and lifelong dependence on costly hormone therapies with significant side effects. The Missouri Catholic Conference urges the committee to vote "DO PASS" on SB 10.

I'm a licensed clinical psychologist in KC. I have 3.800 direct clinical hours working with adult trans clients. They all knew from a young age who they were and not being able to socially and/or medically transition during adolescence stunted their growth. It's hard enough navigating adolescence, let alone doing it when you have to conform to society's conception of gender. It often leads to depression during adolescence and maladaptive coping as a way to survive. Come adulthood, dysphoria does not disappear. It amplifies at some point at which point an individual has to spend thousands of dollars to become the person they always were. It's a painful expensive process that could have easily been avoided. Less than 1% of trans people ever de-transition and even still it's not because they no longer identify as trans but just have obtained what they want from hormones or feel pressure from society and their social environment to conform to their standards, your standards. You are not saving children. Let's just call that for what it is: a euphemism to justify your discrimination. This law actually increases the risk of depression and suicide among trans youth. I write hundreds of letters for gender affirming surgeries and not a single one has been for someone getting surgery under age 18. But again, you know this despite propragandizing sterilization of youth to voters. If this law passes, it will hurt Missourians for generations to come. May you be fortunate enough to never have a politician or non-medical stranger tell you what you can't do medically for yourself or your family.

My husband and I met here and built our lives here as teachers. Our children, both twenty-somethings, are born and bred Missourians. "I love Missouri beauty." That's what our younger child, then a teenager, told me about seven years ago after a weekend of volunteer trail-cutting in the Ozark woods. I loved hearing that, I loved that our child loved our beautiful state. Flash forward to the spring 2023. I asked this child, then twenty-one, where they pictured going after college. Their answer was firm: "Somewhere where I'll have human rights," they said. Along with the rest of our family, they had watched this legislature ban gender-affirming care for minors. They had heard language vilifying people like them, their healthcare providers, and, implicitly, their parents. They were no longer a minor, but they got the message: their access to appropriate healthcare, even as an adult, would no longer be safe in their home state. Our adult child will be 24 in May. Their trans identity is not a phase. They are healthy. They are engaged in their community in their new state. They are a giver whose deep compassion continues to define their life. Professionally, they provide support for people with disabilities--essential human service work.Our adult child still loves Missouri beauty. They love their dad and me. But as a direct result of the trans healthcare ban for youth here, they are building their life elsewhere. Their older sibling is doing so, too, for similar reasons: the state no longer feels safe for our family.Now, when my husband I think a few years ahead to retirement, instead of assuming, as we used to, that we'll retire here in our longtime home state, we must consider spending our retirement years--and our retirement income--near our kids in the locations where they feel safer as LGBTQ people. But here's the thing: I'm also holding onto hope. I hold out hope for Missourian kinds like mine. I hold out hope for their families who want to be able to access best-practice medical care for their children. I hold out hope for this legislature and for the conscience of individual legislators like you, who can see the harmful disruption the genderaffirming care ban has caused in the lives of trans Missourians of all ages, as well as the families who love them. I'm holding onto hope that the good faith that informed the negotiated sunset on that ban will prevail. This testimony is in opposition to SB 10 as it currently reads specifically in regards to the SAFE Act (Section 191.1720) and Participation in Athletic Competitions Designated for the Opposite Sex (Section 163.048) which would remove the sunset clause in both laws. I sit here before you as a person of transgender experience. I first came out at age 14 under duress. The one person who brought me hope growing up in my small town was a fifth grade teacher who successfully advocated for me to be able to continue to interact with my female friends when the boys and the girls were separated for a period of time due to behavior issues. Though I didn't have a word for my gender at the time, she saw me and chose clemency rather than doubly punishing me. Unfortunately, she was the only one for the years that I had left in that school system who showed such understanding. The other teachers who chose to bully me and the students who chose to hurt me led to that moment at age 14 where I had no choice but to come out or die. Fast forward, the world is sinking into darkness for people like me again. Written Testimony in Opposition to SB10Dear Committee Members.I am writing to express my strong opposition to SB10, a bill that seeks to ban gender-affirming care for transgender minors. As a parent of a transgender child, I have seen firsthand the life-saving impact that gender-affirming care has on voung people. This bill is not only harmful but is also an overreach into the private medical decisions made by families in consultation with doctors and mental health professionals. Medical Consensus and the Necessity of CareLeading medical organizations—including the American Academy of Pediatrics, the American Medical Association, and the American Psychological Association—overwhelmingly support access to gender-affirming care for transgender youth. Gender dysphoria is a recognized medical condition, and its treatment follows well-established, evidence-based guidelines developed by experts in pediatric and adolescent healthcare. Prohibiting access to care would contradict decades of research and best practices in medicine. The Harmful Impact of Denying CareStudies show that transgender youth who receive gender-affirming care experience lower rates of depression, anxiety, and suicide. In contrast, those who are denied care are at a significantly higher risk of self-harm and emotional distress. I am in opposition to this bill specifically regarding repealing the sunset dates for "PARTICIPATION IN ATHLETIC COMPETITIONS DESIGNATED FOR THE OPPOSITE SEX (Section 163.048)" and "MISSOURI SAVE ADOLESCENTS FROM EXPERIMENTATION (SAFE) ACT (Section 191.1720)."The main argument that I personally see in defense of Section 163.048 is that "biological males" will dominate girl's sports. There is no statistical evidence to support this in either youth or adult sports. Transgender youth should be able to participate in sports that align with their identity because sports are an important part of many people's lives. They provide exercise, build community, and provide youth with a sense of accomplishment. Youth that participate in sports can learn to work cooperatively as a team with people who are different from them. The issue with Section 191.1720 is that there is that it is blatantly ignorant of what transitioning consists of for children and in denial of several aspects of science. Treating children is a very long-term conversation between the family, the child, and teams of medical professionals. Those medical professionals evaluate things like insistence, persistence, and consistence, which are the metrics used to understand if a child or adolescent may be experiencing gender dysphoria. There are many other policies in place that put roadblocks before stages of medical transition, which often come years after social transitioning and/or the child becoming an adult. However, that is a choice between parents, medical professionals, and youth based on what they believe is the most appropriate form of care, and not the choice of politicians who have no expertise in this area. Allowing this legislation to stay in place means that children who have any sort of documentation on experiencing gender dysphoria are actively being refused necessary treatments. In particular, some children are being refused puberty blockers for precocious puberty because of questioning their gender identity being noted on their medical documents, because prescribing puberty blockers would be considered "aiding their transition." Precocious puberty has many effects on a child's physical and mental health, some of which can last their entire lifetime. To refuse to treat this condition just because a child has also expressed uncertainty about gender identity is heinous and cruel. The majority of recipients of gender-affirming care as minors are cisgender, particularly cisgender male adolescents. If the politicians who insist on banning gender-affirming care for minors truly believed that it was experimental or dangerous, gender-affirming care would be banned for all minors. Yet, legislators insist on denying transgender youth and their families the dignity and autonomy that their cisgender peers are afforded.

I am writing to express my opposition to the repeals of 2027 expiration dates for PARTICIPATION IN ATHLETIC COMPETITIONS DESIGNATED FOR THE OPPOSITE SEX (Section 163,048) and MISSOURI SAVE ADOLESCENTS FROM EXPERIMENTATION (SAFE) ACT (Section 191.1720). Both of these policies harm transgender and gender non-conforming youth in Missouri and never should have been enacted in the first place. Repealing their expiration dates will make Missouri an even more hostile environment for trans youth and their families. The ability to participate in sports is recognized as an important activity for youth to experience team building, build social connections, and build positive physical and mental health habits that can last into adulthood. Denving trans youth the opportunity to participate in athletics teams that match their gender puts them in an impossible position; the result is effectively a ban on their participation in athletics. There is no reputable research that has shown a systematic "advantage" of trans athletes over cisgender athletes, especially among pre-pubescent athletes. Nor is there one case of an athlete transitioning in order to succeed in sport. In my view as a researcher and as a former high school athlete, success in the highest levels of any sport is never a matter of complete biological "fairness." For example, gold-medal swimmer Michael Phelps has several biological characteristics that make his body optimal for swimming compared to the the average person (source: https://www.biography.com/athletes/michael-phelp-perfect-body-swimming). In addition, Phelps started competitive club swimming at an early age - money and access to training facilities are also key determinates of success in high-level sport. Framing the exclusion of trans athletes in sport as an issue of "fairness" is a strawman argument. Rather, exclusion of trans athletes is gender-based discrimination. The so-called "SAFE" act is another dishonest framing of an important issue that impacts quality-of-life for transgender and nonbinary youth in Missouri. Gender-affirming care for minors is not "experimental" as the law claims. Puberty blockers have been used since the 1970s to treat precocious (early) puberty in cisgender youth, and since the 1980s to treat gender dysphoria in adolescents. Protocols for hormone replacement therapy (HRT) to treat gender dysphoria in adolescents were established in the 1990s (source: https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/36446328/). Research studies consistently find that puberty blockers, when used to treat gender dysphoria, effectively reduce the odds of clinical depression, suicidal ideation, and suicide attempts among trans and nonbinary youth. Hormone replacement therapy, when appropriate and administered at the direction of a physician, is also associated with decreased suicidality and mental health issues. Bans on gender-affirming care for youth have already had detrimental effects in Missouri, with many families choosing to leave the state in order to access necessary medical care for their children. The Missouri state government should leave decisions regarding any medical care, gender-affirming or not, between youth, their families, and their doctors.

SB 10, sponsored by Senator Hough, will hold a hearing in your committee on Tuesday, April 1st, I opposes this bill, and I encourage you to defeat this bill in committee. SB 10 is first and foremost unconstitutional. It violates Article III, Section 23 of the Missouri Constitution. The bill intends to eliminate the expiration date of certain tax credits, but these tax credits cover multiple subject areas such as:ConstructionChild CareMotion PicturesAgricultureEconomic DevelopmentTeacher Retirement FundingCriminal JusticeHealthcareHigher EthanolMany of these tax credits haven't been subjected to a state audit in almost 20 years or not at all. We don't know if the taxpayers are getting good value from most of these credits. From 2017-2021, there were over \$2.9B in tax credits redeemed. Does anyone know if the state got its moneys worth? Another reason I oppose this bill because of the potential financial impact on the state budget. According to the Fiscal Notes associated with this bill, the financial impact on the state is unknown and in some of the Fiscal Note's comments, the Department of Revenue cannot determine how many people have taken advantage of these tax credits. This potentially leaves the state vulnerable and will have a direct impact on Missouri's budget. Furthermore, some of the proposed tax credits are expired or expiring in 2025 and we have not heard a large demand from the public for extending these tax credits, making us believe extending these tax credits is not necessary. Another issue is the FRA provisions in this bill. For example, Medicaid blows a big hole in our budget. With the federal government reviewing every program, we don't know how the FRA may change. The state legislature as well as the state auditor have a fiduciary responsibility to investigate these tax credits to determine their effectiveness. This bill reeks of special interest carve -outs for political purposes and that's why the Government Efficiency Committee should KILL this bill.
