Missouri Coalition for the Environment is a statewide, advocacy nonprofit organization that works to empower Missourians to protect their environment and health. Senate bill 82 aims to protect Missouri's water resources by regulating the exportation of water outside the state. This bill is essential for ensuring that our water remains available for domestic, agricultural, industrial, and recreational uses within Missouri. Supporting these bills is crucial for safeguarding our water resources and promoting sustainable water management. We support SB 82 and respectfully ask that the committee vote "yes" on this bill. Ensuring that Missouri has control over its water resources is critically important, especially as we see long-term trends towards decreasing precipitation throughout the Midwest and Great Plains, and the drawdown of aquifers in neighboring states. Requiring permits for water export is a critical first step in protecting Missouri's waters from neighboring states who will increasingly look towards water-rich states like ours as a potential source. Other states already have export permits and limitations. Typically, these are states that have historically had less water available to them. Some of these states' laws are limited to groundwater, while others, like this bill, address both ground and surface waters. Colorado and Nebraska for example, limit exports of both. Like this bill, Nebraska law requires legislative approval for water export permits. Other states have gone further. Oklahoma currently has a temporary ban on water exports, enacted in 2018. Other states in the region have limitations on export that are enforced by their state agencies. In 2020, the Iowa Department of Natural Resources rejected a proposal to export groundwater to drought-stricken western states based on that state's beneficial use doctrine. The example from Iowa demonstrates the necessity of this law. Without their export limitations, Iowa would have had no way to prevent hundreds of thousands of gallons from leaving the state, undermining water conservation efforts for the sake of oil and gas drilling in California. While we are not aware of any large-scale proposals for water export from Missouri, it is only a matter of time before one appears. Each year, dozens of proposals, ranging from serious to laughable, are made to export large volumes of water from water-rich states to water-poor ones. Most of these are costly and ill-considered, but without statutory authority to conserve our state's water resources, Missouri would have no way to stop them. We know that states to our west are looking for ways to acquire more water. In our opinion, it is only a matter of time before other states in need of water come knocking at our door. When that time comes, Missouri needs to be able to ensure that any water exports are aligned with our state's existing Water Resources Plan, and do not threaten our water resources. This bill would create just such an assurance. Clean and plentiful water is one of the most critical resources for any state. Unlike certain resources or commodities, there is no substitute for it. This is especially true in a state like Missouri, with both agriculture and outdoor recreation playing important roles in our state's economy. Protecting the quality and quantity of water is critical to the

health of Missouri's economy, and as such, we urge the committee to support SB 82.
