I am writing to express my strong objection to Senate Bill 3 (SB3) for the following reasons: 1. Violation of Missouri Constitution (Art. III, Sec. 38(a)): SB3 subsidizes private development by granting tax credits—effectively cash equivalents—to wealthy private donors for stadium projects. This violates Article III, Section 38(a) of the Missouri Constitution, which prohibits the state from granting public funds to private entities for private purposes. Public resources should not be used to enrich private stadium owners and investors.

2. Selective Tax Breaks and Violation of Local/Special Law Rules: The bill provides selective tax breaks to specific entities, including private donors contributing up to \$50 million for stadium projects. This violates Missouri's constitutional prohibition against local and special laws by granting preferential treatment to a narrow group of beneficiaries, undermining equal application of the law.

3. Non-Compliance with Single Subject and Clear Title Requirements: SB3 fails to adhere to the Missouri Constitution's single subject and clear title requirements. By encompassing multiple stadium projects and complex tax credit schemes, the bill lacks a clear, unified purpose and obscures its true intent, making it difficult for the public and legislators to fully understand its implications.

4. Misallocation of Public Resources: The fiscal note highlights the significant financial burden SB3 places on Missouri taxpayers. Diverting public funds and tax credits to private stadiums—whether for Kansas City teams or a St. Louis stadium—prioritizes the interests of wealthy donors and private entities over critical public needs such as education, healthcare, and infrastructure.

5. This includes not only the KC teams, but St. Louis (a stadium that holds 30,000 people) can all apply.

SB3 represents an unconstitutional and fiscally irresponsible policy that benefits a select few at the expense of Missouri taxpayers. I urge the Committee to reject this bill and prioritize legislation that serves the public interest without violating constitutional principles.

Introduction:

Missouri Senate Bill 3 (SB 3), passed by the Senate in the Dark of Night, is a reckless and fundamentally flawed proposal that commits \$1.5 billion in taxpayer funds to subsidize private stadiums for the Kansas City. This bill is a blatant misuse of public resources, diverting tax dollars to private enterprises and pick winners and losers in the marketplace, a role the government has no business playing. Beyond temporary construction jobs, these projects will maintain the economic status quo, as a similar number of games, fans, and associated spending will occur in Kansas City with replacement stadiums. The government's role is to invest in public goods like infrastructure and disaster relief, not to funnel money to private team owners for facilities regardless of how much incremental economic benefit one may claim. By prioritizing corporate handouts over the public good, SB 3 repeats the mistakes of failed stadium deals, most infamously the St. Louis Rams, which left the city worse off than before the Rams arrived.

The secretive addition of a severability clause at 2:30 a.m. further exposes this bill as a dishonest political stunt designed to guarantee private subsidies while leaving tax cuts to be deemed unconstitutional on grounds of unequal treatment. The Missouri House must reject SB 3 to protect taxpayers, uphold the principle that public funds should serve the public, not private interests, and to block the unethical actions of members of the Missouri Senate.

Tax Dollars Should Not Fund Private Enterprises or Pick Winners and Losers:

The core objection to SB 3 is its misuse of taxpayer dollars to bankroll private businesses, specifically the Chiefs and Royals, under the false promise of economic prosperity. Governments should not act as venture capitalists, using public funds to pick winners and losers in the private sector. Stadiums are private enterprises that primarily benefit team owners, developers, and a narrow subset of fans, while taxpayers bear the financial risk. By funneling \$1.5 billion to these projects, SB 3 distorts the free market, favoring two sports franchises over other businesses or public priorities like education,

infrastructure, or disaster relief. This approach not only undermines economic fairness but also sets a dangerous precedent for future corporate welfare schemes. Missourians do not deserve a government that gambles our money on private ventures with dubious returns.

Financial Burden on Taxpayers:

SB 3's \$1.5 billion commitment imposes an unethical burden on Missouri's approximately 2.8 million taxpayers. Your cost figures likely understate the true impact, as stadium projects often incur cost overruns or additional subsidies. Meanwhile, SB 3 allocates a mere miniscule fraction in aid for Tornado disaster victims, highlighting inhumane, skewed priorities. Taxpayers should not be forced to subsidize private stadiums when critical public needs go underfunded, especially when the government's role is to serve all citizens, not select private entities.

Failure of Taxpayer-Funded Stadiums & The St. Louis Rams' Debacle:

The promise of economic benefits from taxpayer-funded stadiums is a proven myth, and the St. Louis Rams' TWA Dome (now The Dome at America's Center) is a stark warning for Missouri. Built in 1995 with \$280 million in public funds (about \$560 million in 2025 dollars), the dome was pitched as a driver for downtown economic growth, promising jobs, tourism, and tax revenue. Today, walk the St. Louis streets to witness the spectacular results:

- Negative Economic Impact: Studies, including a 2016 Brookings Institution report, show stadiums like the dome deliver minimal economic benefits to communities. Most jobs were low-wage and temporary (e.g., concessions, security), and spending largely benefits team owners, not local businesses. A 2016 analysis confirmed the dome's economic impact fell far short of promises. St. Louis is a hollow shell of itself before the Rams arrival.

- Team Abandonment: In 2016, the Rams, owned by Stan Kroenke, relocated to Los Angeles, leaving the dome largely empty and taxpayers responsible for ongoing debt. By 2016, St. Louis city and county were paying \$12 million annually in bond repayments, with costs continuing into the 2020s. The "Battle Dome" now hosts occasional events but costs millions in maintenance (e.g., \$2.5 million annually in recent years) for an underutilized facility.

- National Trend: An Urban Institute study (2018) found that 80% of publicly funded stadiums fail to deliver promised economic benefits, costing taxpayers billions while enriching private owners. SB 3's claims of \$2 billion in economic activity and 13,000 jobs for Kansas City are inflated, risking more empty stadiums if teams relocate, even with clawback provisions that may be hard to enforce. Least we forget, replacing the existing stadiums will result in little economic growth beyond construction jobs because the surrounding area is already saturated with jobs related to the seasonal sporting events.

Infamous: Stan Kroenke St. Louis Scam -

The name Stan Kroenke remains forever infamous in the St. Louis area for his betrayal and exploitation of St. Louis taxpayers in the Rams' fiasco. Kroenke secured \$280 million in public funds for the stadium, only to abandon the city for Los Angeles in 2016, leaving behind a near-empty arena and taxpayers burdened with debt. His actions exposed the folly of entrusting public funds to private team owners who prioritize profit over loyalty. The legislature must not forget Kroenke's scam when considering SB 3, which risks repeating this mistake by committing \$1.5 billion to teams that could leave Kansas City, saddling taxpayers with more costly, underused facilities. Missouri cannot afford to pick winners like Kroenke again, only to lose. If you think you will win, use your money to play the Missouri Lottery.

Severability Clause: Unethical Political Trickery -

The addition of a severability clause to SB 3 at 2:30 a.m. reeks of unethical political fleecing of Missouri tax payers. This clause, designed to ensure the bill's stadium funding survives if other provisions are struck down, appears crafted to sneakily invite a legal challenge to the knowingly unconstitutional unequal tax treatment, which will be used to cancel the bill's paltry tax credits and guarantee billions in subsidies to billionaires. Added in the Dark of Night, this move undermines transparency and demonstrates an intent to prioritize billionaires' interests over ethical behavior* (*If not unethical, certain Senators should resign out of incompetence or due to gross negligence.) Such deception

further erodes public trust in a bill already skewed toward private enterprises.

Conclusion:

SB 3 is a fiscally reckless bill that misuses +\$1.5 billion in taxpayer funds to subsidize private stadiums, violating the principle that governments should not pick winners and losers or fund private enterprises.

SB 3 would merely replace existing venues without adding new teams or games, thus maintaining the economic status quo besides temporary construction jobs. Basic economics demonstrate claims of economic growth are grossly exaggerated at best. The City of St. Louis, decimated with economic blight, stands as a haunting reminder of that truth. The Dark of Night severability clause exposes SB 3's true intent to provide corporate welfare and pretend to offer tax cuts. The Missouri House must reject this bill to protect taxpayers, provide any notion of basic integrity, and ensure public funds serve the common good, not private profits.

The Association opposes SS#2/SCS/SB 3. The Senate version requires most Missouri counties to conduct a local vote no later than next April to impose some version of a countywide limitation on residential property reassessments. The Association opposes this portion of the bill.

The property tax provides about 60% of school operating funds statewide. Residential property taxes have a connection to student enrollment and the costs of school funding. The Association is concerned that the property tax limitations will have significant adverse effects on school revenues and the function and perception of the property tax in many districts. Particularly for the counties required to vote to freeze residential property taxes, the new provision, if approved, is likely to reduce local revenue growth and create a tax-based financial incentive that limits mobility and homeownership opportunities. The provision will also create increased pressure to raise taxes on other types of property and create substantial tax disparities for similar properties.

The differential treatment of the various counties raises concerns due to inconsistent application of property taxation across the state. Also, some school districts overlap two or more counties and could be subject to different requirements for different taxpayers in the same district due to this bill.

For these reasons, the Association opposes SB 3. Thank you for the opportunity to offer our concerns regarding this bill.

A reduction in, or limitation on the growth of, local revenue from personal or real property taxes poses a significant threat to individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) who rely on essential services funded through local tax levies. Senate Bill 40 organizations, like Callaway County Special Services (CCSS), are mandated to assess local needs and invest in a network of high-quality, person-centered supports across the lifespan.

Under Senate Bill 3, Callaway County is among the counties subject to a 5% annual cap on property tax increases for eligible homeowners. While this is not a retroactive funding cut, it imposes a structural ceiling that will slow the natural growth of tax revenues used to sustain and expand critical services. As demand for support increases, and inflation drives up the cost of care, this artificial cap restricts the flexibility of organizations like CCSS to respond effectively.

CCSS serves over 200 individuals with IDD, but the reach of our programs extends well beyond the individuals served. When we support individuals with IDD, we also stabilize families, empower caregivers, strengthen local employers, and communities. Through our property tax levy, CCSS funds employment services, inclusive recreation, life skills training, transportation, and family supports, none of which are luxuries. They are foundational, and they reflect our community's values of equity, inclusion, and opportunity.

SB 3's long-term effect is a gradual erosion of our ability to meet rising needs. Without proactive adjustments, either in exemption structures, inflation indexing, or alternative funding mechanisms, these statutory limitations will strain services, delay innovation, and risk regression in inclusion and independence for people with IDD.

We urge lawmakers to safeguard the essential role that property tax levies play in supporting IDD services. If revenue restrictions are implemented, a sustainable and equitable replacement model must be developed. Otherwise, we risk undercutting decades of progress and the very infrastructure that allows individuals with IDD to live, work, and thrive in the communities they call home.

The Missouri Municipal League opposes the property tax provisions in SB 3, as they create			

inconsistency in property tax assessment practices across the state of Missouri. This inconsistency could lead to unequal treatment of individual taxpayers.

Senate Bill 3 introduces uncertainty regarding the availability of revenue to support debt service on general obligation bonds. These voter-approved bonds are essential for funding critical local infrastructure projects.

During the 2025 regular session of the Missouri General Assembly, extensive discussions and debates highlighted the need for a deeper evaluation of local property assessment practices before implementing any changes to existing laws. It was hoped that this evaluation would take place in the time leading up to the 2026 legislative session. However, if SB 3 is enacted, it would make any significant reforms to the property assessment process unattainable.

We are opposed to the perfected version of SB 3 because it includes several violations of the constitutional limits on legislative powers found in Article 3 of the Missouri Constitution,

Those violations include single subject, clear title, prohibition of certain local or special laws, the prohibition to "grant public money or property, or lend or authorize the lending of public credit, to any private person, association or corporation" found in Article 3, Section 38(a), and various equal treatment clauses.

There seems to be misconceptions about the source of funding for the subsidies available in SB 3. They ARE NOT all just from tax revenue generated by sports franchise activities. And the subsidies are available to PRIVATELY owned projects, not just public facilities.

SB 3 provides for transferable tax credits owners in sports franchises can receive as kick-backs for spending money on a "professional sports franchise's headquarters facility and training facility."

As it left the Senate, SB 3 (2025 1st Extraordinary Session) includes some of the most blatant violations of the limits on legislative power in quite some time.

Those violations include:

Single Subject Clear Title Local or Special Law Equal Treatment

Clear title and single subject lawsuits are crap shoots -- it's hard to tell how the courts might deal with any given bill, but the prohibition of the legislature "to grant public money or property, or lend or authorize the lending of public credit, to any private person, association or corporation" in Article 3, Section 38(a) and the prohibition of passing local and special laws in Article 3, Section 40 has been enforced by the courts more vigorously in recent times.SB 3 is also a blatant violation of the prohibition of local and special law in Article 3, Section 40 because it does not provide ALL areas of the state the same protection against escalating property taxes.

The historical reasons for constitutional limits on local and special laws is similar to those relating to Article 3, Section 38(a). Read about it in this article from 1920: http://mofirst.org/docs/Harper_%20Local -and-Special-Legislation.pdf

That article tells the story of an address by the Constitutional Convention explaining why they included the Article 3, Section 40 limits on local and special laws:

"The evils of local and special legislation have become enormous" says the address."We need but look to our session acts to be satisfied that this species of legislation occupies the larger portion of the time of our General Assemblies, to the neglect and prejudice of public interests, The expense to the state in passing and publishing such laws and the combinations by which private interests have been advanced and dangerous monopolies created are well known." See page 24.

Quite recent Missouri Supreme Court opinions have reinforced the long-standing requirement that the sort of discrimination found in SB 3 be based on a rational basis. There is no rational basis for the distinctions made in SB 3, and even if there were, the provisions of Article 3, Section 42 should have been followed.

Stadium Financing Violates Missouri Constitution

The language for the stadium bill financing could also violate the Missouri Constitution. Specifically, how the tax credits proposed for the Kansas City Chiefs and Royals could potentially violate Article III. Section 38(a), and Section 39(5).

SCS SB 3 repeals and enacts four sections—67.3000, 67.3005, 100.240, and 135.445—aiming to bolster the state's economy and resilience through tax credits and expenditures for sporting events, donations, athletic facilities, and disaster relief.

The Missouri Supreme Court's ruling in Curchin v. Missouri Industrial Development Board, 722 S.W.2d 930 (Mo. banc 1987), shapes this analysis, emphasizing strict scrutiny of tax credits as potential grants of public money. Each section of the bill is examined for compliance, considering the constitutional framework, the Curchin precedent, and the balance between public and private benefits.

How is it Unconstitutional?

Article III, Section 38(a) of the Missouri Constitution restricts the General Assembly from giving or lending state credit or public funds to private entities, except in cases of a legislatively defined public purpose, emergencies, or voter-approved obligations. Courts often defer to legislative findings of public purpose, but the benefit must be clear and primary.

Section 39(5) further prohibits direct grants of public money or property to private persons, associations, or corporations, with limited exceptions tied to constitutional provisions or overwhelming public interest. In Curchin, the Missouri Supreme Court struck down a tax credit for bond defaults under Section 100.297, ruling it a grant of public money that primarily benefited private bondholders, not the public, despite claims of economic development. These precedent demands that any financial incentive-tax credits, expenditures, or otherwise-primarily serve the public, not private entities, and inform the scrutiny of SCS SB 3.

Curchin v. Missouri Industrial Development Board (1987) redefines the analysis, treating tax credits as

grants of public money and demanding a primary public purpose. Sections 67.3000 (refundable credits), 67.3005 (transferable credits), and 100.240 (expenditures, credits for franchises) likely violate Article III, Section 38(a), as private benefits to sponsors, donors, or teams may dominate. Section 100.240 also risks breaching Section 39(5) via direct expenditures. Section 135.445 stands firm, serving a public, emergency need. Courts will weigh the public-private balance, but Curchin tilts sections 67.3000, 67.3005, and 100.240 toward unconstitutionality.
