SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 1Offered by Hansenof 3Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill Nos. 1768 & 2060, Page 58, Section 140.010, Line 46,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "143.998. ~~Every person filing an individual income~~
 4 ~~tax return form under this chapter shall place in the space~~
 5 ~~provided on said form the number assigned by the department~~
 6 ~~of revenue to the school district of which the person filing~~
 7 ~~is a resident.]~~ 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to
 8 the contrary, for all tax years beginning on or after
 9 January 1, 2026, the department of revenue shall annually
 10 provide to the department of elementary and secondary
 11 education a report including the information required by
 12 this section for the previous tax year. Such report shall
 13 include:

14 (1) The average Missouri individual adjusted gross
 15 income per return for the entire state; and

16 (2) The average Missouri individual adjusted gross
 17 income per return for each school district in the state.

18 2. The provisions of this section shall not be
 19 construed to require the department of revenue to report any
 20 personally identifiable information of any taxpayer."; and
