1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill Nos. 1838, 1692, 1695, 1983, 2036, 2662
2 & 2743, Page 11, Section 301.190, Lines 116-130, by deleting said lines and inserting in lieu
3 thereof the following:
4

5 "10. (1) When an application is made for an original Missouri certificate of ownership
6 for a motor vehicle previously registered or titled in a state other than Missouri or as required by
7 section 301.020, it shall be accompanied by a current inspection form certified by a duly
8 authorized official inspection station as described in chapter 307, except as provided under
9 subdivision (2) of this subsection. The completed form shall certify that the manufacturer's
10 identification number for the vehicle has been inspected, that it is correctly displayed on the
11 vehicle and shall certify the reading shown on the odometer at the time of inspection. The
12 inspection station shall collect the same fee as authorized in section 307.365 for making the
13 inspection, and the fee shall be deposited in the same manner as provided in section 307.365. If
14 the vehicle is also to be registered in Missouri, ~~the safety inspection required in chapter 307~~
15 ~~and] the emissions inspection required under chapter 643 shall be completed and[only] the fees~~
16 required by ~~[section 307.365 and] section 643.315 shall be charged to the owner~~. This section
17 shall not apply to vehicles being transferred on a manufacturer's statement of origin.

18 (2) A licensed new or used motor vehicle dealer who has sold at least two hundred
19 vehicles in the previous calendar year may complete the inspection form required under
20 subdivision (1) of this subsection for any motor vehicle:

21 (a) Having less than thirty thousand miles for the three-year period following the model
22 year of manufacture; or

23 (b) Sold to a person who lives in another state and intends to register the vehicle in
24 another state.

26 Any motor vehicle dealer who intentionally completes an inspection form improperly or with
27 incorrect information shall be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the provisions of
28 this chapter, which may include suspension or revocation of their dealer's license. Any motor
29 vehicle dealer who completes an inspection shall submit the completed form to the department of
30 revenue in a manner prescribed by the department. Such inspections and inspection forms shall
31 be completed on licensed dealership premises."; and

33 Further amend said bill, Page 14, Section 307.350, Lines 1-19, by deleting said lines and
34 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

 17 Further amend said bill, Page 17, Section 307.380, Lines 4-8, by deleting said lines and inserting
 18 in lieu thereof the following:

 20 "such vehicle before it is again operated on the highways of this state. At the seller's
 21 expense every used motor vehicle of the type required to be ~~[inspected by section 307.350]~~
 22 registered by section 301.020 shall immediately prior to sale be fully inspected regardless of any
 23 current certificate of inspection and approval, and an appropriate new certificate of inspection
 24 and approval, sticker, seal or other device shall be obtained no more than sixty days prior to the
 25 date of sale, except that such inspection shall not be required for a motor vehicle sold to a person
 26 who lives in another state and intends to register the vehicle in another state; for a motor vehicle
 27 registered as a historic motor vehicle, as defined in section 301.010; for a motor vehicle
 28 registered as a local commercial motor vehicle used for farm or farming transportation
 29 operations, as described in section 301.010; or for a motor vehicle having less than thirty
 30 thousand miles for the three-year period following the model year of manufacture. The seller of
 31 a motor vehicle required to be inspected under this subsection shall present the certificate of
 32 inspection and approval to the buyer at the point of sale, unless the buyer waives such
 33 presentation, and the buyer shall be required to submit the certificate of inspection when
 34 applying for registration of the vehicle."; and

 36 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Line 19, by inserting after the number "3." the
 37 following:

 39 "A police officer may issue a citation upon observation of a vehicle on any highway with
 40 two or more defective components. The citation shall be reported to the Missouri state highway
 41 patrol. The owner of such vehicle shall cause the vehicle to be inspected and obtain a certificate
 42 of inspection and approval, sticker, seal, or other device from a duly authorized official
 43 inspection station and shall submit such official certificate of inspection and approval, sticker,

1 seal, or other device to the Missouri state highway patrol within sixty days of the issuance of the
2 citation. If a certificate of inspection and approval, sticker, seal, or other device is not submitted
3 to the Missouri state highway patrol within sixty days of the issuance of the citation, the
4 registration information of such vehicle shall be reported by the Missouri state highway patrol to
5 the director of revenue and the director shall suspend the registration of such vehicle and not
6 renew the registration until a certificate of inspection and approval, sticker, seal, or other device
7 is obtained.

8 4. For the purposes of this section, the term “components” refers to any safety equipment
9 described in written instructions issued by the superintendent of the Missouri state highway
10 patrol to official inspection stations pursuant to subsection 1 of section 307.360, including, but
11 not limited to, brakes, lighting equipment, signaling devices, steering mechanisms, horns,
12 mirrors, windshield wipers, tires, wheels, exhaust system, glazing, air pollution control devices,
13 and fuel system.
