2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "3. (1) No political subdivision using a progressive
 4 design-build contract under this section shall be required
 5 to include, as a condition of eligibility, the following:
 6 evaluations, awards, or points based upon any requirement,
 7 certification, standard, or policy that is not directly
 8 related to the construction, safety, durability, permitting,
 9 or operation of the project.

10 (2) The provisions in subdivision (1) of this
 11 subsection shall include, but not be limited to:

12 (a) Green building certification or rating systems;

13 (b) Sustainable development goals, plans, or climate-
 14 related goals;

15 (c) Environmental, social, political, ideological, and
 16 governance standards, or similar nonpecuniary standards;

17 (d) Environmental justice, social justice, diversity,
 18 equity, or inclusion objectives; and

19 (e) Any preference for materials, designs,
 20 contractors, subcontractors, consultants, or vendors based
 21 on political, social, environmental, or ideological criteria
 22 rather than cost, quality, safety, durability, lawful
 23 permitting, or ability to perform the work.

24 4. Nothing in subsection 3 of this section shall be
 25 construed to prohibit a political subdivision from requiring
