20 "(2) The moving party shall be solely responsible for all duties enumerated under this
21 section. If the juvenile officer forwards to the prosecutor a class A or B felony that is not
22 certified by the juvenile officer, the prosecutor shall notify the juvenile officer within thirty days
23 of the decision to certify the case."; and

25 Further amend said bill and section, Page 6, Line 52, by deleting the word "all" and inserting in
26 lieu thereof the words "legally sufficient"; and

28 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Lines 57-58, by deleting the words "reportable under
29 section 43.506" and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
