1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2372, Page 5, Section 190.098, Lines  
2 24-31, by deleting said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3  
4 "supervisory standards established by the medical director. A community paramedic shall  
5 provide services of a health care plan if the plan has been developed by the patient's physician or  
6 by an advanced practice registered nurse through a collaborative practice arrangement with a  
7 physician or a physician assistant through a collaborative practice arrangement with a physician  
8 and there is no duplication of services to the patient from another provider."; and

10 Further amend said bill, Page 12, Section 195.417, Line 62, by inserting after said line the  
11 following:

13 "(5) The fees required under this subsection shall be assessed against each manufacturer  
14 solely on the basis of sales transactions involving that manufacturer's own compounds, mixtures,  
15 or preparations sold in or into the state. No manufacturer shall be assessed fees based upon  
16 transactions attributable to the compounds, mixtures, or preparations of any other  
17 manufacturer."; and

19 Further amend said bill, Page 55, Section 376.1765, Line 16, by inserting after said section and  
20 line the following:

22 "407.3007. 1. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

23 (1) "Artificial intelligence" or "AI":

24 (a) Any artificial system that performs tasks under varying and unpredictable  
25 circumstances without significant human oversight or that can learn from experience and  
26 improve performance when exposed to data sets;

27 (b) An artificial system developed in computer software, physical hardware, or other  
28 computer systems that solves tasks requiring human-like perception, cognition, planning,  
29 learning, communication, or physical action;

30 (c) An artificial system designed to think or act like a human, including cognitive  
31 architectures and neural networks;

32 (d) A set of techniques, including machine learning, that is designed to approximate a

1 cognitive task; or

2 (e) An artificial system designed to act rationally, including an intelligent software agent  
3 or embodied robot that achieves goals using perception, planning, reasoning, learning,  
4 communicating, decision-making, and acting;

5 (2) "Mental health professional", the same as defined in section 632.005. The term  
6 "mental health professional" shall also include any person licensed in a profession regulated  
7 under chapter 337.

8 2. Any person or entity that develops or deploys artificial intelligence in the state shall  
9 not advertise or represent to the public that the AI is or is able to act as a mental health  
10 professional or is capable of providing therapy services, psychotherapy services, or a mental  
11 health diagnosis.

12 3. Any violation of this section shall be considered an unlawful practice under the  
13 Missouri merchandising practices act under this chapter.

14 4. The attorney general shall enforce the provisions of this section. Any individual may  
15 report violations of this section to the attorney general. If the attorney general finds that a  
16 violation occurred, the attorney general shall commence a civil action in a court of competent  
17 jurisdiction. If the court finds that a violation occurred, the court may grant damages, civil  
18 penalties, injunctive relief, attorney's fees, and any such other relief the court finds appropriate.  
19 Notwithstanding section 407.100 to the contrary, civil penalties shall be as follows:

20 (1) Ten thousand dollars for the first violation; or

21 (2) Twenty thousand dollars for any subsequent violation."; and
