27 5. Any video lottery game operator or video lottery game retailer with a video lottery
28 game, video lottery terminal, or other gambling device in use prior to the passage of this act or
29 any gambling device that would otherwise be determined to be illegal through the passage of the
30 provisions of this section and sections 313.425 to 313.445 shall as a condition of continued
31 operation before August 28, 2028, submit to the commission any financial records related to
32 each video lottery game, video lottery terminal, or other gambling device and any records
33 indicating installation, storage, and maintenance of each gambling device at its current physical
34 location. Such records shall be referred to and reviewed by the office of the attorney general.

35 6. Any video lottery game operator or video lottery game retailer described in subsection
36 5 of this section may elect to remove any video lottery game, video lottery terminal, or other
37 gambling device from the business premises of the video lottery game retail establishment upon
38 the passage of the provisions of this section and sections 313.425 to 313.445. Any gambling
39 device that is removed shall not be replaced with the same or similar gambling device. Any
40 gambling device that becomes non-functioning shall be permanently removed from the business
41 premises of the video lottery game retail establishment and shall not be replaced with the same
42 of similar gambling device."; and
