1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2989, Pages 17-18, Section 313.435,  
2 Lines 1-27, by deleting said section and lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "313.435. 1. A municipality may adopt an ordinance allowing or prohibiting video  
5 lottery game terminals within the corporate limits of such municipality within one hundred  
6 twenty days after the effective date of this act. Such municipality shall notify the commission of  
7 the ordinance within seven days of passage. A municipality that has adopted such an ordinance  
8 may at any time thereafter adopt a new ordinance to allow video lottery game terminals within  
9 the corporate limits of such municipality.

10 2. A county commission may, for the unincorporated area of the county, adopt an  
11 ordinance prohibiting video lottery game terminals within the unincorporated area of the county  
12 within one hundred twenty days from the effective date of this act. Such county shall notify the  
13 commission of the ordinance within seven days of passage. A county commission that has  
14 adopted such an ordinance may at any time thereafter adopt a new ordinance to allow video  
15 lottery game terminals within the unincorporated area of the county.

16 3. Any municipality or county adopting an ordinance that prohibits the licensing of video  
17 lottery games shall notify the commission of such action and provide a certified copy of such  
18 ordinance to the commission. Upon receiving such notification and ordinance, the commission  
19 shall not license video lottery game retailers within such area covered by such municipal or  
20 county ordinance.

21 4. If any such municipality or county that has opted to prohibit the use of video lottery  
22 game terminals to play video lottery games repeals such ordinance and adopts an ordinance  
23 allowing video lottery game terminals within such municipality or county, then such  
24 municipality or county shall notify the commission, and the commission may license video  
25 lottery game retailers within such municipality or county to conduct video lottery games."; and

27 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
28 accordingly.
