ASSUMPTION

§302.171 – Sex Designations on Driver’s Licenses

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assume the following regarding this proposal:

The proposed language (302.171.12) defines that a person applying for a license, permit or nondriver identification card issued with a gender other than the applicant’s biological gender assigned at birth, shall present and amended birth certificate that reflects the new designation.

The change would require an amendment to policies that allow for presentation of a court order or medical documentation of reassignment surgery to mandate that only a change to the birth certificate to reflect the new designation would be accepted. Requestors would not have any other option, other than the amended birth certificate.

Administrative Impact

The proposed change may require a modification to remove documents other than an amended birth certificate from the list of documents to request a change to the sex designation in the driver record and on printed credentials. This change will require:

- Driver license system modifications by vendor to remove other designation change documents
- User testing of required system changes
- Update procedures and forms
- Update website
- Update MO Driver Guide
- Training for employees

FY 2027 - Driver License Bureau

Research/Data Analyst 100hrs. @ \$37.14 per hr. = \$3,714

FY 2027 - Strategy and Communications Office

Oversight assumes DOR will use existing staff and will not hire additional FTE to conduct these activities; therefore, Oversight will not reflect the administrative costs DOR has indicated on the fiscal note.

FUSION Impact

DOR notes an Implementation Consultant 200 hrs. @ \$225 per hr. = **\$45,000**

Oversight does not have information to the contrary and therefore, **Oversight** will reflect the FUSION estimate as provided by **DO**R.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, **Oversight** will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for this agency.
