FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§192.021 - Public Health Services

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS)** state §192.021.1 of the proposed legislation authorizes the Department to contract with the Missouri affiliate of the National Network of Public Health Institutes. The section does not require particular contracts to be entered into with any such organization, and therefore this provision has no fiscal impact.

§192.021.2 of the proposed legislation requires an annual report of any grants made.

It is assumed that the Department can absorb the costs of this bill with current resources. However, if the workload significantly increased or other legislation was enacted, additional resources would be requested through the appropriation process.

Oversight notes that the above-mentioned agency has stated the cost of the proposal can be absorbed. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Office of Administration** defer to the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan for the potential fiscal impact of this proposal.

Officials from the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above-mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
