ASSUMPTION

§130.031 - Modifies Requirements for Campaign Contributions

Officials from the **Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC)** state the proposed legislation does not have fiscal impact on the MEC. It is assumed this prohibition would result in a minimal number of complaints; however, if this assumption is incorrect the Commission may require additional staff resources.

Oversight notes that the above-mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact for this agency in the fiscal note.

Oversight notes the proposal allows the MEC to impose a civil penalty on a committee violating the provisions of this bill of up to 100 times the amount of the contribution received in violation of these provisions. Oversight notes the MEC expects a minimal number of complaints; therefore, Oversight will not reflect an impact in the fiscal note.
