FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight notes officials from **St. Louis County** did not respond to Oversight’s request for fiscal impact for this proposal.

§§67.547 and 67.5420 - Sales Tax for Early Childhood Educational Services

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** note this proposal clarifies how revenue collected from a county sales tax for childhood education should be deposited and spent. This will not fiscally impact DOR.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** and the **City of Kansas City** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the above-mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Oversight notes St. Louis County already has the authority for the local sales tax. Oversight assumes this proposal clarifies where the funds shall be distributed. Therefore, Oversight assumes no fiscal impact from the proposal.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Budget and Planning (B&P)** defers to the political subdivisions for the fiscal impact.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local political subdivisions were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
