FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services** did not respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact for this proposal.

§§476.050, 476.055, 476.056, 476.1025, 478.250, 483.005, 483.082, 483.140, 483.390, 509.520, and 510.030 – Court Operations

Officials from the **Department of Corrections, Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, Department of Social Services, Office of Administration, Office of the State Public Defender, Office of the State Treasurer, Missouri House of Representatives** and **Missouri Senate** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Rule Promulgation

Officials from the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules** assume this proposal is not anticipated to cause a fiscal impact beyond its current appropriation.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)** note many bills considered by the General Assembly include provisions allowing or requiring agencies to submit rules and regulations to implement the act. The SOS is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of normal activity resulting from each year's legislative session. The fiscal impact for this fiscal note to the SOS for Administrative Rules is less than \$5,000. The SOS recognizes that this is a small amount and does not expect that additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, the SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed by the General Assembly in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the office can sustain with its core budget. Therefore, the SOS reserves the right to request funding for the cost of supporting administrative rules requirements should the need arise based on a review of the finally approved bills signed by the governor.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, various county officials were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
