AN ACT

To amend chapter 537, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to civil actions for certain damages.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 537, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 537.041, to read as follows:

537.041. 1. As used in this section, "artificial intelligence" means an engineered or machine-based system that varies in its level of autonomy and that can, for explicit or implicit objectives, infer from the input it receives how to generate outputs that can influence physical or virtual environments.

2. Any image, video, or audio that is generated or modified using artificial intelligence shall contain a mark or statement that is visible or audible to users that the image, video, or audio is generated or modified using artificial intelligence. Such mark or statement shall be developed by the secretary of state, and such mark or statement shall be used by all persons or entities publishing or disseminating any image, video, or audio generated or modified using artificial intelligence.

3. Any person who has suffered injury for a violation of subsection 2 of this section shall have standing to bring a cause of action against the publisher or disseminator of the image, video, or audio for damages.
