## AN ACT

To amend chapter 37, RSMo, by adding thereto three new sections relating to the Missouri GIS advisory council.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 37, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto three new sections, to be known as sections 37.1300, 37.1310, and 37.1320, to read as follows:

37.1300. For the purposes of sections 37.1300 to 37.1320, the following terms 2 mean:

- (1) "Council", the Missouri GIS advisory council established in section 37.1310;
- (2) "Geographic information system (GIS)", a computer system for capturing, storing, checking, and displaying data related to positions on the Earth's surface that enables easily seeing, analyzing, and understanding patterns and relationships;
- (3) "Geospatial", relating to or denoting data that is associated with a particular location:
- "Missouri Spatial Data Information Service" or "MSDIS", Missouri's primary spatial data clearinghouse responsible for collecting and distributing vector 10 data, aerial photography, and light detection and ranging elevation data that are generated, updated, and funded by state, local, and regional agencies and governments.

37.1310. There is hereby established within the office of administration the "Missouri GIS Advisory Council", which is charged with assisting and advising the

- state in ensuring the availability, implementation, and enhancement of a statewide
- geospatial data infrastructure common to all jurisdictions. The council shall be

- safety entities, including Next Generation 911.

- 37.1320. 1. The council shall consist of the following members at a minimum:
- 2 (1) The commissioner of administration or the commissioner's designee;
  - (2) The director of the department of conservation or the director's designee;
  - (3) The director of the department of economic development or the director's designee;
- (4) The director of the department of health and senior services or the director's 6 7 designee;
- The director of the department of natural resources or the director's 8 **(5)** 9 designee;
- 10 The director of the department of the National Guard or the director's 11 designee;
  - (7) The director of the department of public safety or the director's designee;
    - (8) The director of the department of transportation or the director's designee;
- 14 The director of the United States Geological Survey or the director's 15 designee;
  - (10) The chief of the United States Department of Agriculture or the chief's designee;
    - (11) The chair of the Missouri 911 service board or the chair's designee;
- 19 (12) The director of the Missouri Spatial Data Information Service or the 20 director's designee;
  - (13) The director of the state land survey program or the director's designee;
  - (14) The director of the National Geospatial Intelligence Agency West; and
  - (15) Fourteen citizens of Missouri appointed by the commissioner of the office of administration. These individuals shall represent city, county, local, and federal government; the private sector; public safety; and academia.
  - 2. By invitation of the council, additional subject matter experts may participate in activities as noncouncil members. Such noncouncil members shall not be required to be appointed by the commissioner of administration.
- 3. Appointed members of the council shall serve two-year terms and shall serve until their successors are appointed. Vacancies on the council shall be filled in the same 30 manner as the original appointment, and such member appointed shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term. 32

4. The council shall meet at least quarterly and as otherwise required by the commissioner of the office of administration or the office of geospatial information.

- 5. The council shall designate from its members a chair and chair-elect for oneyear terms and shall adopt written guidelines to govern the management of the council.
- 6. Each member of the council shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for his or her actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his or her duties as a member of the council, subject to appropriation.
- 7. The council shall designate from its members an executive secretary for the council, who shall maintain the records and decisions of the council's activities in accordance with state law and shall be responsible for correspondence between the council and other agencies.
- 8. The council shall not collect the personally identifiable information of any individual person. For purposes of this subsection, the term "personally identifiable information" means information that can be used to distinguish or trace an individual's identity including, but not limited to, name, Social Security number, or biometric data records, either alone or when combined with other personal or identifying information that is linked or linkable to a specific individual.
