## AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to noncompete clauses in physician employment contracts.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 191.265, to read as follows:

191.265. Any noncompete clause of an employment contract between an  
2 employer and a physician licensed under chapter 334 that restricts the right of the  
3 physician to practice medicine in any geographic area for any period of time after the  
4 termination of such employment relationship shall be void and unenforceable, provided  
5 that nothing in this section shall render void or unenforceable the remaining provisions  
6 of any such employment contract.
