AN ACT

To amend chapter 643, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to air conservation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 643, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 643.680, to read as follows:

3 **643.680. 1. The intentional injection, release, or dispersion, by any means, of**
4 **chemicals, chemical compounds, substances, or apparatus within the borders of this**
5 **state into the atmosphere with the express purpose of affecting temperature, weather, or**
6 **the intensity of the sunlight is prohibited.**

7 **2. The air conservation commission of the state of Missouri established under**
8 **section 643.040 shall establish standards and guidelines for the enforcement of this**
9 **section.**

10 **3. The department of natural resources may promulgate all necessary rules and**
11 **regulations for the administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that**
12 **term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this**
13 **section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the**
14 **provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter**
15 **536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly**
16 **pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul**
a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority
and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2026, shall be invalid and void.
