AN ACT

To amend chapter 68, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to port authorities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 68, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be
2 known as sections 68.300 and 68.310, to read as follows:

**68.300. 1. The state auditor shall conduct quarterly audits on all port authorities
2 in the state.**

**3 2. In addition to quarterly audits required under subsection 1 of this section, the
4 auditor shall audit a port authority when requested to do so by a petition submitted by a
5 person who resides or owns real property within the city or county that formed the port
6 authority if such petition is submitted in the same manner as required by section 29.230.**

**68.310. 1. All records produced or held by a port authority shall be public
2 records under the provisions of chapter 610.**

**3 2. All port authorities shall publish, within ten business days of creation, the
4 following documents:**

5 (1) Development agreements;

6 (2) Payment in lieu of taxes schedules;

7 (3) Deed restrictions and covenants;

8 (4) Notices of intended change of use for projects; and

**9 (5) Any studies or reports related to public interests or economic impacts of the
10 projects of the port authority.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

11 **3. Before January 1, 2027, port authorities shall publish all records listed in**
12 **subsection 2 of this section and in their possession on August 28, 2026.**
