## AN ACT

To repeal section 9.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to election day.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 9.010, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu  
2 thereof, to be known as sections 9.010 and 173.015, to read as follows:

9.010. The first day of January, the third Monday of January, the twelfth day of  
2 February, the third Monday in February, the eighth day of May, the last Monday in May, the  
3 nineteenth day of June, the fourth day of July, the first Monday in September, the second  
4 Monday in October, **the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even-**  
5 **numbered years**, the eleventh day of November, the fourth Thursday in November, and the  
6 twenty-fifth of December, are declared and established public holidays; and when any of such  
7 holidays falls upon Sunday, the Monday next following shall be considered the holiday.  
8 There shall be no holiday for state employees on the fourth Monday of October.

**173.015. The board shall require that all colleges and universities be closed on**  
2 **the general election day, unless such college or university serves as a polling place.**
