

HB 1640 -- ACCOMMODATIONS FOR ADMISSIONS TEST

SPONSOR: Overcast

This bill requires that beginning in the 2027-28 academic year public institutions of higher education no longer accept standardized exam scores from any entity that requires a disabled applicant to have a comprehensive test for a documented disability within the two years before the applicant seeks accommodations for an exam.

The bill defines a "disabled applicant" as one that has a lifelong or static disability.
