

HB 2050 -- SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENTS

SPONSOR: Terry

This bill requires that a school superintendent that is employed by a school district must reside within that district if the district or any school within the district is:

- (1) Classified as unaccredited;
- (2) Facing the loss of accredited status; or
- (3) Experiencing a funding deficit.

This requirement also applies to any superintendent that is shared with multiple districts. If any of the districts or schools within the districts meet the specified criteria above the superintendent must reside within one of the districts.
