

HB 2119 -- PROPERTY ASSESSMENT CLEAN ENERGY ACT

This bill revises the Property Assessment Clean Energy Act by making it inapplicable to residential property. The bill provides guidance for any residential properties approved for the program between January 1, 2022 and August 28, 2026.

The bill clarifies that a clean energy development board can acquire loans or assessment contracts from other states and their municipalities and political subdivisions to serve a common purpose of providing financing support or credit enhancement for any project.

This bill also changes the maximum financing duration on commercial property assessment clean energy loans from 20 years to 30 years.

This bill is similar to HB 1155 (2025).
