

HB 2466 -- RECORDS OF ADDRESSES OF STATEWIDE ELECTED OFFICIALS

SPONSOR: Jones (12)

Currently, public records of governmental bodies are considered open records under Missouri sunshine law. Certain records and pieces of information are exempted from this requirement and considered closed records.

This bill adds the addresses of statewide elected officials and members of the General Assembly to the list of closed records. This provision will not be construed to modify residency requirements for such officials and members.
