

HB 2569 -- CIVILIAN REVIEW BOARDS

SPONSOR: Smith (46)

This bill excludes any civilian review board in any city with more than 125,000 but fewer than 160,00 inhabitants from the limitations of power placed on civilian review boards, and it allows such city to grant to a civilian review board, division, or any other entity the power to receive, investigate, make findings, and recommend disciplinary action upon complaints by members of the public against members of the police department.

Upon enactment, this bill applies to the City of Columbia.

This bill is the same as HB 1186 (2025).
