

HB 2632 -- THE USE OF CREDIT SCORES TO DETERMINE AUTOMOBILE
INSURANCE RATES

SPONSOR: Murray

This bill prohibits automobile insurance companies from utilizing any information obtained directly or indirectly from a consumer reporting agency or any insurance credit score that relies on information obtained directly or indirectly from a consumer reporting agency for the purpose of determining a rate for a policy.

This bill is similar to SB 852 (2026).
