

HB 2736 -- SAME-DAY VOTER REGISTRATION

SPONSOR: Woods

Currently, a person must be registered to vote by 5:00 p.m. on the fourth Wednesday prior to the date of the election in order to vote in that election.

This bill would remove that deadline, permitting a voter to register to vote on or before the day of the election.

The voter may register to vote at any location established by the Secretary of State or by the election authority of the jurisdiction where the voter resides for voter registration, or at the voter's assigned polling location.

This bill is similar to HB 1143 (2025) and HB 2243 (2024).
