

HB 2821 -- NONCOMPETE CLAUSES IN PHYSICIAN EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES

SPONSOR: Doll

This bill prohibits the enforcement of any noncompete clause of an employment contract between an employer and a physician that restricts the right of the physician to practice medicine in any geographic area for any period of time after the termination of an employment relationship between the employer and the physician.

This bill is similar to HB 2184 (2026).
