

HB 2835 -- PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BENEFITS FOR OFFENDERS

SPONSOR: Collins

This bill repeals current provisions of law allowing individuals convicted of certain drug offenses to participate in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) only if certain conditions are met. Under this bill, individuals who are convicted of a state or federal felony drug offense will not be excluded from SNAP for such conviction.

This bill is the same as HB 730 (2025).
