

HB 2868 -- COLLECTION OF BIOLOGICAL SAMPLES

SPONSOR: Parker

Currently, a biological sample must be collected from every person who is found guilty of a felony or any unlawful sexual offense or from every adult who is arrested for burglary in the first degree or burglary in the second degree or a felony offense under Chapter 565, 566, 567, 568, or 573, RSMo. Under this bill, a biological sample must be collected from every person who is found guilty of an unlawful sexual offense and any adult who is arrested for any felony or burglary in the second degree. If it is determined that a person's biological sample has been included in the relevant database and has not been subject to a court order expunging the record from the database, no additional sample will be required.

This bill is similar to SB 1458 (2026).
