

HB 2887 -- ULTRA-PROCESSED FOOD IN SCHOOLS

SPONSOR: Jones (88)

This bill establishes the "Missouri Healthy Schools Act" and prohibits public schools from serving, selling, or allowing a third party to sell "ultraprocessed food", as defined in the Act, on campus during the school day.

Beginning with the 2027-2028 school year, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education must post on its website a standardized form that public schools may use to certify compliance with the provisions of the Act, along with a list of each public school that has provided the certification of compliance to the Department.

This bill is similar to SB 1290 (2026).
