

HB 2936 -- CONVEYANCE OF STATE PROPERTY

SPONSOR: Riggs

This bill authorizes the conveyance of several pieces of State-owned land. The Governor is authorized to convey:

- (1) The Briarwood State School in Cass County;
- (2) The Kirksville Regional Office in Adair County;
- (3) The Landers State Office Building in Greene County;
- (4) The Department of Labor and Industrial Relations Building in Greene County;
- (5) An easement on the grounds of the State National Guard's Festus Readiness Center in Jefferson County;
- (6) The State National Guard's Doniphan Readiness Center Building in Ripley County. This property is to be conveyed to the City of Doniphan;
- (7) Rolling Meadows State School in Lafayette County;
- (8) The Environmental Services Program/Division of Environmental Quality building in Cole County;
- (9) The Richwood Tower Site in Washington County;
- (10) Lakeview Woods State School in Jackson County;
- (11-12) The MoDOT Welcome Center in Marion County.

The Commissioner of the Office of Administration must set the terms and conditions for the conveyance as the Commissioner deems reasonable. Such terms and conditions can include, but not be limited to, the number of appraisals required and the time, place, and terms of the conveyance. The Attorney General must approve the form of the instrument of conveyance.
