

HB 3025 -- PERIOD PRODUCTS PROVIDED IN CHARTER AND PUBLIC SCHOOLS

SPONSOR: Rush

Beginning on July 1, 2027, this bill requires every school district and charter school in which 40% or more of the students reside in households with a household income that does not exceed 185% of the most recent poverty guidelines to provide period products in the restrooms for all middle school, junior high, and high school buildings in which there are students in grades six through 12 at no charge to the students. "Period Products" are defined as tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the menstrual cycle.

This bill is similar to HB 1435 (2025) and to HB 2370 (2024).
