

HB 3036 -- TRANSIENT GUEST TAX

SPONSOR: Reedy

Upon voter approval, this bill allows the governing body of a city with more than 2,700 but fewer than 3,000 inhabitants located in a county with more than 50,000 but fewer than 60,000 inhabitants and with a county seat with more than 17,000 but fewer than 21,000 inhabitants to impose a tax of up to 5% on the charges for sleeping rooms and campground sites paid by transient guests for general revenue purposes.

Upon enactment, this bill applies to Knob Noster.

This bill is the similar to HB 1192 (2025).
