

HB 3044 -- CITY TRANSIENT GUEST TAX

SPONSOR: Laubinger

Upon voter approval, this bill would allow the governing body of a city with more than 8,000 but fewer than 9,000 inhabitants and located in a county with more than 60,000 but fewer than 70,000 inhabitants to impose a tax of up to 5% on the charges for sleeping rooms paid by transient guests in the city.

The proceeds of this tax can be used solely for the promotion of tourism and related economic development purposes.

Upon enactment, this bill will apply to Park Hills.
