

HB 3060 -- AMBULANCE DISTRICTS

SPONSOR: Peters

This bill allows a municipal, county, or district hospital that operates a licensed ambulance service to petition to establish an ambulance district within its political boundaries by an act of its duly elected board of trustees. The board must file the petition with the county clerk of the county in which the hospital is located, in lieu of a public petition.

After the ambulance district has been declared organized, the hospital board of trustees will serve as the ambulance district board of directors. The terms and qualifications of the ambulance district board of directors will follow the same as current law governing hospital boards of trustees.
