

HB 3112 -- CONCEALED-CARRY RIGHTS OF RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

SPONSOR: Phelps

This bill specifies that "retired officers", as that term is defined in the bill, shall be provided with an identification card upon the payment of \$100. The identification card shall list certain information, as described in the bill, including the verification of the retired officer's eligibility for the concealed carry of a firearm.

This bill also requires law enforcement agencies that have issued identification cards to maintain a roster of retired officers, to reissue lost identification cards for a fee, to offer firearms training, and to use collected fees for specific purposes.
