

HB 3128 -- PROHIBITING FOREIGN INFLUENCE ON LOBBYING ACTIVITIES

SPONSOR: Keathley

This bill prohibits a lobbyist from receiving any compensation for carrying out any lobbying activity on behalf of a foreign adversary, a foreign political party of a foreign adversary, or a foreign adversary client.

A lobbyist who violates this will be subject to an action for disgorgement of any compensation the lobbyist received, as well as a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 per violation.

An action can be filed by the Attorney General. The Attorney General can issue subpoenas for information regarding a violation. The Attorney General can also file a civil action to enforce this.

This bill is similar to SB 1380 (2026).
