

HB 3158 -- DRIVER'S LICENSES

SPONSOR: Boyko

Currently, an application for a new or renewal driver's license, nondriver's license, or instruction permit must be accompanied by proof of lawful presence or citizenship and no driver's license, nondriver's license, or instruction permit may be issued by the Department of Revenue to an illegal alien or other person who cannot prove his or her lawful presence. Driver's licenses issued to an illegal alien in another state are not honored by this State for any purpose.

This bill repeals the section of law prohibiting issuing licenses to, or honoring licenses of, illegal aliens and persons unable to prove lawful status.

The bill eliminates the application requirement to prove lawful status or citizenship for noncommercial, non-REAL ID compliant licenses and permits and prohibits information collected during the license application process from being furnished or used for the purposes of immigration enforcement.
