

HB 3252 -- PERSONS LACKING MENTAL CAPACITY TO UNDERSTAND CERTAIN PROCEEDINGS

SPONSOR: Ealy

This bill requires a prosecuting attorney and a victim or victim's family to be notified if a person deemed mentally incompetent to stand trial is:

- (1) Transferred to a different facility, including whether there has been a change in security level;
- (2) Placed on conditional or unconditional release or discharged from commitment; or
- (3) Restored to be competent to stand trial.
