

HB 3265 -- FINES AND FEES IN JUVENILE COURT

SPONSOR: Johnson

This bill prohibits the court from ordering a parent or guardian of a child committed for institutionalization to pay for costs of support, maintenance, or treatment of the child.

This bill also eliminates any fines or fees that can be charged to a child and prohibits the court from imposing on a minor or a parent or guardian of the minor an assessment based on the actions of the minor.

This bill is similar to HB 2338 (2024).
