

HB 3290 -- PUBLIC ENTITY CONTRACTS

SPONSOR: Plank

Currently, under the "Anti-Discrimination Against Israel Act" a public entity must not enter into a contract with a potential value of \$100,000 or more with a company for services, supplies, information technology, or construction unless the contract includes a written certification that the company is not, and will not until the contract is complete, engaged in a boycott against:

- (1) The State of Israel;
- (2) Companies doing business in or with Israel;
- (3) Companies authorized by, licensed by, or organized under the laws of Israel; or
- (4) Persons doing business in Israel.

This bill repeals the Anti Discrimination Against Israel Act.
