

HB 3293 -- PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES

SPONSOR: Brown

Currently, children under the age of seven are required to wear a personal flotation device when on board any watercraft in the State. This bill raises the age to 12, and requires such children to wear personal flotation devices while in navigable public waters more than three feet deep. These requirements are lifted when a person under the age of 12 is supervised by a lifeguard.

This section of law will be known as "Hannah's Law".

This bill is similar to SB 1216 (2026).
