

HB 3309 -- STUDENT WALKOUTS AND DEMONSTRATIONS

SPONSOR: Seitz

This bill prohibits students from establishing, organizing, or participating in any protest activity on or off the property of a public school during regularly scheduled instructional periods of learning if such activity materially and substantially disrupts the public school's operations.

The bill outlines consequences for students, teachers, and school districts or charter schools and provides that school districts and charter schools may adopt content-neutral policies governing the time, place, and manner of student expression.

Students must not be disciplined solely for engaging in peaceful expression unless such conduct meets the criteria in the bill.
