

HB 3353 -- LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IDENTIFICATION

SPONSOR: Young

This bill requires any law enforcement officer, defined in the bill, performing official duties in the State to visibly display identification as specified in the bill. The officers are prohibited from wearing facial coverings that conceal or obscure their facial identity in the performance of official duties unless otherwise authorized by law. The bill provides exceptions to the requirements of this bill. A willful and knowing violation of the provisions of this bill is a class A misdemeanor.
