

HB 3386 -- EXPENDITURES BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

SPONSOR: Wellenkamp

This bill requires that, before June 30, 2027, any unexpended balance in the subaccounts of the Natural Resources Protection Fund exceeding the preceding biennium's collections revert to the General Revenue Fund at the end of each biennium. Beginning July 1, 2027, any unexpended balance in the subaccounts of the Natural Resources Protection Fund that exceeds the preceding biennium's collections will not revert to the General Revenue Fund. Beginning July 1, 2027, and annually on July 1st of each year thereafter, the Commissioner of Administration must use taxable sales reports to estimate the amount of state general revenue sales and use tax derived from electric power distribution in the previous calendar year and report the amount to the State Treasurer. The Treasurer must transfer certain amounts from the general revenue sales, as specified in the bill. The bill repeals provisions relating to the transfer of funds from the Missouri Air Emission Reduction Fund.

This bill is similar to SB 953 (2026).
