

HB 3490 -- LOCAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION

SPONSOR: Jones (12)

Currently, each city, town, and village, and each county, regardless of classification, has the authority to create a historic preservation commission, and to grant the commission certain powers and authorities.

This bill provides that a city with more than 400,000 inhabitants located in more than one county cannot designate any property or any building of any public or private college or university as historic and subject it to the city's requirements related to historic preservation.

Upon enactment, this will apply to Kansas City.
